
## Trafficking in Persons

20% of the victims were non-Japanese citizens!



More than 50% of the victims were under 18!



You're just not aware ...

You or someone close to you might be a victim.

Your friend who has signed a contract as a fashion model is threatened.





Your friend might be forced to appear in pornographic videos.

Persons being offered "You can run away from home and stay at my house."



They might be targeted as victims of obscene acts.

Persons looking for a "sugar daddy" or offering prostitution service on SNS.



Your children might be forced or coerced to engage in sexual acts.

A foreign worker saying "my passport has been taken away."



They might be forced to do unreasonably heavy work.
