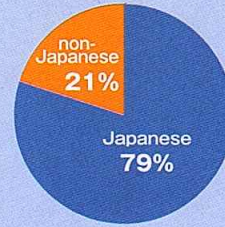


# Trafficking in Persons

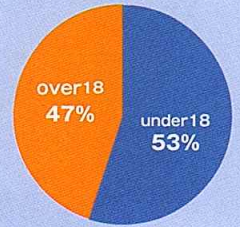
## It's not someone else's problem!

in Japan

**20%**  
of the victims were  
non-Japanese  
citizens!



More than  
**50%**  
of the victims were  
under 18!



You're just  
not aware ...

### You or someone close to you might be a victim.

Your friend who has signed a contract  
as a fashion model is threatened.



**Your friend might be forced  
to appear in pornographic videos.**

Persons looking for a "sugar daddy"  
or offering prostitution service on SNS.



**Your children might be forced  
or coerced to engage in sexual acts.**

Persons being offered "You can run away  
from home and stay at my house."



**They might be targeted  
as victims of obscene acts.**

A foreign worker saying  
"my passport has been taken away."



**They might be forced  
to do unreasonably heavy work.**

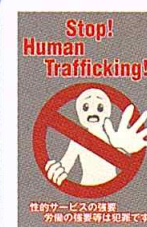
